

Informational Meeting Announcement for the Buffalo Flats Stream Restoration Project

The Union Soil and Water Conservation District (District) is leading a planning effort to investigate the physical and biological conditions of Catherine Creek and Little Creek upstream of Union, Oregon. This planning effort will develop strategies to improve fish and wildlife habitat conditions while investigating opportunities to address flooding concerns of the local community and provide benefits for agricultural operators. The District recognizes the complexity of the natural river system and the potential for impacts on the local community, and will carefully consider the ramifications of design alternatives in this process.
